- 5K/1M Fun Run** (Spring) - Volunteer to help with planning and hosting the ASFS 5K and 1M Fun Run. (Typically held on a Saturday morning.)
- Art Show** (May/June) - Assist with preparation and/or hosting for the annual spring student art show.
